<p>Pyrus calleryana</p> <p><i>Capital Pear</i></p> <p><i>The Capital Pear is a deciduous tree to 8 metres with lustrous, dark green leaves. The autumn season brings reddish-purple leaves while spring brings abundant white flowers. <p>Lagerstroemia indica</p> <p><i>Crepe myrtle</i></p> <p><i>The Crepe myrtle gets its common name from the beautiful display of ruffled flowers which appear in late summer and early Autumn. <p>Grevillea robusta</p> <p><i>Silky Oak</i></p> <p><i>Native to Queensland and New South Wales, the silky oak is a large upright tree with spreading lower branches. <p>Ulmus parvifolia</p> <p><i>Chinese Elm</i></p> <p><i>A lovely shade and specimen tree with highly ornamental bark and thick, glossy dark green leaves.
