Pyrus calleryana  Capital Pear  The Capital Pear is a deciduous tree to 8 metres with lustrous, dark green leaves. The autumn season brings reddish-purple leaves while spring brings abundant white flowers. It produces a small insignificant fruit which is inedible.	Thrings. Lagerstroemia indica  Crepe myrtle  The Crepe myrtle gets its common name from the beautiful display of ruffled flowers which appear in late summer and early Autumn. A deciduous tree to 6 metres, its mid-green leaves turn yellow, red or orange (depending on the variety) in Autumn leaving a beautifully coloured mottled trunk during the winter months.
