## **Animal Management**

## What animals am I allowed to keep?

From 14 November 2011, Western Downs Regional Council is working under a new set of local laws to replace the local laws of the former Council areas and provide consistency across Western Downs. One of the local laws which was adopted is *Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011*, which specifics the type and/or number of animals which are prohibited to be kept in certain areas or may only be kept with a permit. Council has these laws to ensure that animals are not kept in numbers that could cause a nuisance to nearby neighbours. In large numbers, and on certain allotments, some animals can act as a pack, or may be very difficult to clean up after.

The areas in which prohibitions and permits are required are defined as designated town areas. These areas can be identified on Council's website, or at any Council office.

Bees	<ul> <li>(a) More than 2 hives on an allotment with an area more than 400m² but less than 1,000m²</li> <li>(b) More than 5 hives on an allotment with an area of 1,000m² or more but less than 2,000m²</li> <li>(c) More than 10 hives on an allotment with an area of 2,000m² or more, but less than 4,000m² (see Code of Practice for Urban Bee Keeping in Queensland 1998)</li> </ul>	A hive on an allotment with an area less than 400m² (see Code of Practice for Urban Bee Keeping in Queensland 1998)

<sup>\*</sup>A prohibition does not apply to the keeping of an animal or animals on premises if—

- the animal or animals were kept on the premises before the commencement of the authorising local law; and
- (a) (b) the keeping of the animal or animals on the premises immediately before the commencement of the authorising local law did not contravene any provision of a local law of the local government that was repealed contemporaneously with the making of the authorising local law.
