*Please note, the recycling of clean, contaminant free timber (not classed by the site supervisor as Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste) and green waste is free for domestic users but attracts a fee for commercial users. This fee is significantly lower than the Commercial and Industrial (C&I) rate and covers the cost of mulching the material. Similarly there is a fee to process concrete and masonry (payable by both residents and commercial users) to cover the costs of processing the stockpiled concrete.

Recycling Dos

- Glass bottles and jars (make sure to remove lids)
- Plastic containers and bottles from kitchen, bathroom and laundry
- Paper and cardboard
- Steel and aluminum cans and empty aerosols
- Milk and juice cartons

Recycling Donts

- Nappies and polystyrene foam
- Plastic bags, packets and film
- Light bulbs, mirrors, window glass, ceramics, crockery and glasses
- Syringes, medical waste, chemicals and pesticides
- Food scraps, garden waste and grass clippings
- Every week our Waste Team services over I3,000 properties across the region
- Over 7,000 tons of waste is collected in general waste bins each year
- Our communities are great Western Downs Waste Warriors but our recycling has a contamination rate of over 15%
