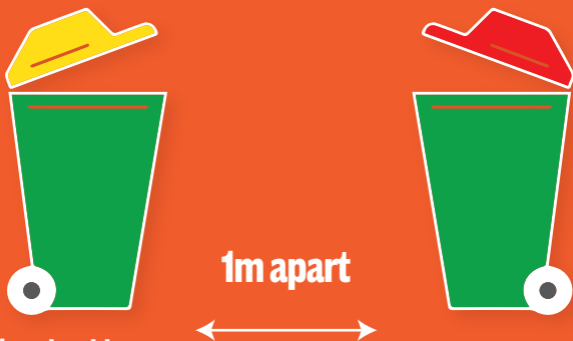


GENERAL WASTE GUIDE

SIMPLE WAYS TO REDUCE WASTE AT HOME

- Compost your food and garden wastes
- Take a re-usable bag when you go shopping
- Avoid impulse purchases
- Buy in bulk whenever possible
- Put a "No Junk Mail" sticker on your letterbox
- Have a garage sale
- Buy durability not disposability
- Swap magazines and books
- Give clothes and toys to charity
- Don't buy items with excessive packaging

HOW TO PLACE YOUR BIN ON THE KERB



Bins should:

- Be a maximum of 1m from the kerb
- Have handles facing your property and the opening facing the street
- Be out before 6am on day of collection
- Not be overfull - lids must close fully
- Not be overweight - must be less than 40kg
- Be placed clear of cars, trees and other obstacles

Chemical drums*	drumMuster Program
China / Crockery	Garbage wheelie bin
Clothing	Clothing bins for local charities
Computers	Transfer station or landfill
Electrical appliances*	Transfer station or landfill
Furniture	Transfer station or landfill
Food scraps	Compost bin or worm farm
Gas cylinders	Transfer station or landfill
Garden clippings	Compost bin
Herbicide containers	drumMuster Program
Kitty litter	Dig into garden or garbage bin
Light bulbs	Garbage wheelie bin
Mattresses	Transfer station or landfill
Mobile phones	MobileMuster Program
Nappies	Garbage wheelie bin
Oil (car)*	Transfer station or landfill
Ovenware	Garbage wheelie bin
Paint tins (dry & empty)*	Transfer station or landfill
Plastic bags	Garbage wheelie bin
Scrap metal	Transfer station or landfill
Smoke detectors	Garbage wheelie bin
Tyres	Prohibited
Window glass	Garbage wheelie bin
White goods*	Transfer station or landfill
Yellow pages	Recycling wheelie bin

*Contains toxic substances - do not place in garbage or recycling bins.
