WHAT IS A BUSINESS CONTINUITY CANVAS?

The Business Continuity Canvas is a strategic management tool to inform business continuity planning. It allows you to enact your response and recovery plan in the case of an emergency or unforeseen event.

The Business Continuity Canvas, is based on the Business Model Canvas by Strategyzer, and intended to sit alongside the Business Model Canvas and the Business Impact Canvas.

The Business Impact and Continuity Canvas were developed to help businesses simplify and streamline their ideas in preparing a Business Continuity Plan.

We recommend that multiple pages can be created based on example or probable crisis or risk scenarios, for example one Continuity Canvas for a flooding event, one Continuity Canvas for a cybersecurity event, and so on.

The intention is that a business prepares a Business Impact Canvas and Business Continuity Canvas together to understand the risk and impacts, and a plan to respond.
