Myall Remembrance Park Services Memorial Wall

About the Services Memorial Wall

Western Downs Regional Council worked with the RSL and community members to develop the services memorial at the Myall Remembrance Park in Dalby.

Initiated by a local community member the projects' intention is to provide community members with the opportunity to memorialise and honour those who have served Australia in war time, in peace keeping activities or active duty.

The memorial is situated on a defined area of the Myall Remembrance Park (lawn cemetery). The two large stone pillars allow for families to purchase bronze plaques for memorialisation of their loved ones who have served in the Armed Forces.

Who can be memorialised on the Services Memorial Wall?

Only persons who have served in the Australian Armed Forces and have a registered service number will be eligible to be memorialised on the Services Memorial Wall. This includes participation in active duty, reserve service or peace keeping missions.

Who can apply for a memorial plaque on the Services Memorial Wall?

Applicants can be family members on behalf of those that served and are now deceased.

How do I apply for a memorial plaque on the Services Memorial Wall?

An Application for Myall Remembrance Park Services Memorial Wall Plaque needs to be completed by the applicant. This application can be found on Council's website at www.wdrc.qld.gov.au or alternatively at any WDRC Customer Service Centre.

Do I have to provide evidence of service or a badge number?

The applicant will have to supply Council a copy of the Statement of Service and Permission to use Service Badge to go with the application. To obtain a copy of these official documents please go to www.dva.gov.au/commemorations-memorials-and-war-graves/office-australian-war-graves or alternatively contact the Office of Australian War Graves on: 1800 555 254. All documents will then need to be supplied to Council.

What is the fee for the memorial plaque?

The fee for the memorial plaque is determined every financial year by WDRC and can be found under Council's Adopted Fees and Charges on our corporate website.

How long will it take to fabricate the memorial plaque?

Please allow 8-10 weeks for fabrication of the plaque.

When will the memorial plaque be attached to the Services Memorial Wall?

Council will provide at the time of submitting your application the next installation date.

What size is the memorial plaque?

The plaque size is 100mm x 75mm.
