DELIVERY OF ARTWORK

Artworks and quilts are to be delivered to Tara Customer Service Centre, 19 Fry Street Tara QLD 4421, between **9am and 4pm** from **Monday 6 to Friday 10 October**.

No work will be accepted outside these times unless by arrangement with Council's Community Activation Officer, Amy Hallinan.

COLLECTION OF UNSOLD ARTWORK

Work must be collected between 8am and 5pm on **Monday 27 or Tuesday 28 October** unless other arrangements have been made.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All exhibition items are to be displayed at the individual artist's own risk. Western Downs Regional Council accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to work.
2. Exhibition items will be accepted from all artists and artist groups across the Tara & District.
3. Works **must not have been previously exhibited in any Tara or Regional Artists' Exhibitions**.
4. A maximum of five (5) artworks can be submitted per artist.
5. Textile Artists can submit a maximum of three (3) quilts.
6. Senior Art Students (aged between 15-18 years) can exhibit up to three (3) pieces.
7. Exhibition items should be ready to hang or display. All hanging works must be mounted and framed with D rings approximately 8cm from the top of the work. Clear installation instructions must be provided if required.
8. There is no limitation on size or dimensions of works. However if you are planning something 'out of the ordinary', please contact Amy Hallinan to discuss feasibility of installation requirements.
9. All items must be clearly marked with the artist name, title of the work and cost of the item (if the item is available for sale) on the back of the artwork.
10. Artworks are to be delivered to Tara Customer Service Centre, between 9am and 4pm on Monday 6 and Friday 10 October. If delivery during these times is not possible please advise so alternative arrangements can be made.
11. Works can be in any medium including painting & works on paper, textile art, 3-dimensional art, photography and arts & crafts.
12. All items must be available for the duration of the exhibition and sold items can be collected at the end of the exhibition.
13. Showcase space is limited and it cannot be guaranteed that all items submitted will be displayed.
14. All items sold will be subject to a commission of 10% which will be donated to Life Flight.
15. All payments for exhibition sales are to be made payable to Tara Family Support Committee Inc, not the individual artists. Tara Family Support Committee Inc will forward payment to the individual artist following the exhibition.
