



SOLID & LIQUID WASTE ENQUIRIES

To clarify whether Council's Waste, Utilities or Environmental Health Sections are best to respond to your query, please refer to the below.

Q: Is the waste solid or liquid?

If your waste is solid, Council's Waste Section will be able to assist you with your queries.

If your waste is liquid ...

Q: Is the waste sewerage?

Yes? Please contact Council's Utilities Section.

No? ...

Q: Is the waste grease trap waste, drilling mud, oily water, car wash residue, grit/solids trap material, reverse osmosis plant brine, cellar water?

Yes? Unfortunately Council does not have points for storage, disposal or treatment of these wastes.

No? ...

Q: Is the waste uncontaminated stormwater?

Yes? Following provision of evidence stating that the stormwater is not contaminated, Council may provide approval for discharge to stormwater drain. If the waste is contaminated discharge must not occur, as it is a serious environmental offence.

Enquires relating to stormwater contamination may be directed to Council's Environmental Health Section.
