TERMS OF REFERENCE

- Only persons who have served in the Australian Armed Forces and have a registered service number will be eligible to be memorialised on the Myall Remembrance Park Services Memorial. This includes participation in active duty, reserve service or peace keeping missions.
- Council has determined the size and design for plaques to be affixed to the memorial and therefore will be responsible for arranging for the procurement of such to ensure conformity.
- The wording, badges and layout for each plaque shall conform to the example provided on page 2 of this application.
- Plaques will not be ordered until Council receives a duly completed Application for Myall Remembrance Park Services Memorial Wall Plaque, Statement of Service and Permission to use Service Badge together with the prescribed fee.
